WA Labor will create METROHUBS across the metropolitan area to deliver sensitive, sustainable and vibrant local communities for an improved quality of life.

Jobs

METROHUBS will be a major driver of new jobs located within communities where people live.

METROHUBS will be a key focal point for commercial and social activity and the delivery of services to residents living nearby.

Some METROHUBS would build on existing infrastructure such as universities and hospitals to leverage community assets into innovative job creating activity centres. An example of this would be Murdoch with its potential as a medical science, research and education based hub.

Public transport and congestion

METROHUBS will be linked to a co-ordinated and integrated transport network to significantly reduce urban congestion.

Creating METROHUBS across Perth would also mean more people working where they live so less need for people to travel long distances for work.

METROHUBS encourage natural decentralisation, reduce over concentration elsewhere and helps address congestion on our roads.

Planning and housing

METROHUBS will be aggressively pursued and underpinned by a revolution in planning to provide uniformity, consistency and certainty for local government, business and residence.

METROHUBS would be developed in both new suburbs and in older established areas.

METROHUBS will be activity centres that match quality infill with amenity by creating a village-style mix of open space, housing, workplaces and entertainment venues.
